Friday, Oct 8th 2027 • Piedmont, Italy • • Villa d'Amelia

Upon arrival at Malpensa Airport, you will be warmly welcomed by your English speaking tour leader and transferred by private vehicle to your hotel, Villa d'Amelia, nestled in the heart of the Piedmont countryside. En route, enjoy a leisurely stop at Paul Cullen's vineyard, Cantine Povero, where you will be introduced to the celebrated wines of the region through a tasting experience that offers the perfect first taste of Piedmont. Depending on your flight schedule, lunch may be enjoyed at the winery (not included) or upon arrival at the hotel (not included). Settle into your hotel for an evening at leisure!

Sat, Oct 9th 2027 • Alba, Italy • • Villa d'Amelia

This morning, depart for the picturesque town of Alba, the capital of the UNESCO recognized hilly landscape of Langhe and home to the world famous International White Truffle Fair. Take time to wander through the vibrant fair, where the aromas, colors, and flavors of the region come together in a lively celebration of local tradition, artisanal products, and gourmet specialties. After enjoying some time at leisure in Alba, continue to the Roero wine region for a tasting at Tenuta Cucco or a similar estate, where you will discover the renowned Barolo wines and learn more about the vineyards, terroir, and winemaking heritage that define this exceptional corner of Piedmont. Return to Villa d'Amelia in the afternoon, with time to relax before dinner at the hotel.

Sun, Oct 10th • Langhe, Italy • • Villa d'Amelia

After breakfast at the hotel, meet your guide and private driver for a transfer into the wooded hills of Piedmont, where an unforgettable truffle hunting experience awaits. Learn about the traditions of truffle hunting, the special bond between hunter and dog, and the art of identifying this prized delicacy as you explore the beautiful countryside. Following the excursion, enjoy lunch at Trattoria del Bivio or a similar local restaurant, where the flavors of Langhe cuisine are paired with the seasonal black truffle. In the afternoon, continue with a hazelnut experience at a traditional ciabot, a rustic vineyard hut, to discover the region's hazelnut traditions and specialties before returning to the hotel for an evening at leisure.

Breakfast and lunch included

Mon, Oct 11th • Canelli, Italy • • Villa d'Amelia

Today, travel with your English-speaking tour leader to the charming town of Canelli, long celebrated as the heart of Asti Spumante production. Visit a prestigious winery such as Contratto or a similar estate, where you will explore historic cellars, discover the traditional methods behind Piedmont's sparkling wines, and enjoy a tasting that showcases the elegance and character of this renowned region. Continue with lunch at a traditional restaurant in Canelli or nearby, before returning to your hotel in the afternoon with time to relax and enjoy the peaceful countryside at your own pace. In the evening, dinner is at leisure.

Breakfast and lunch included

Tues, Oct 12th • Bra, Italy • • Villa d'Ameilia

After breakfast at the hotel, begin the day with a hands on cooking class at Braja Farm, where you will discover the traditions of Piedmontese cuisine and learn the art of making fresh pasta, including tajarin and stuffed ravioli. After preparing your dishes, enjoy a relaxed lunch featuring your creations, paired with local wines in a warm and welcoming setting. In the afternoon, continue to Bra, the birthplace of the Slow Food movement, where you will experience some of the region's culinary treasures, including a tasting of local salsiccia at an artisan butcher and Piedmontese cheeses at one of Italy's most renowned cheese refiners. Return to the hotel in the afternoon with the remainder of the day at leisure.

Wed, Oct 13th • Piedmont to Verona • • Grand Hotel Des Arts

Depart your hotel in Piedmont and enjoy a scenic journey toward Verona, with a stop en route in the renowned wine region of Oltrepò Pavese, the largest wine producing area in Lombardy. Here, visit a distinguished winery such as Tenuta Mazzolino or a similar estate, where you will discover the traditions and craftsmanship behind northern Italian winemaking. Continue with a wine paired lunch featuring regional specialties before travelling on to Verona, where you will arrive in the afternoon and check into your hotel. The evening is yours to enjoy at leisure, with the option of dinner at the hotel or at a nearby local restaurant.

Thurs, Oct 14th • Lake Garda, Italy • • Grand Hotel des Arts

Continue past the elegant Isola del Garda, the picturesque Punta San Vigilio, and the refined Villa Canossa before arriving in the historic village of Lazise. Afterwards, continue into the celebrated Valpolicella wine region for a visit to Masi Tenuta Canova, where you will discover the secrets behind its world renowned wines, including Amarone, and enjoy a leisurely lunch at the estate. Return to Verona in the afternoon, with dinner at leisure.

Fri, Oct 15th • Verona, Italy • • Grand Hotel des Arts

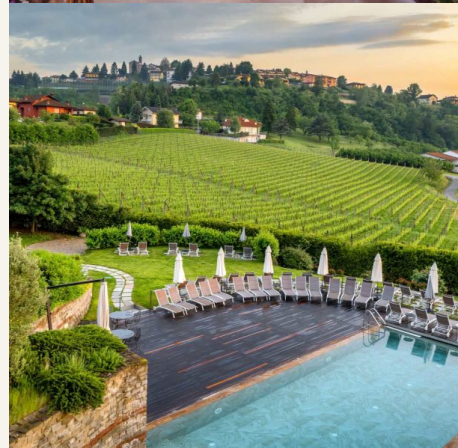

Cancellation Schedule & Fees:

Original date of deposit to July 15th 2027- First and second deposits are non refundable

July 16th through travel dates- 100% of vacation package is nonrefundable

Premium Travel Insurance: Refunds are available for cancellations due to covered medical reasons when insurance is purchased through reliable travel insurance companies. These reputable companies offer insurance that both provides excellent coverage even when the covered medical reason might be a pre-existing condition as well as refund of out of pocket expenses while traveling (each insurance company stipulations outlined in their policy and brochure). You, the passenger, or your immediate family is responsible to file a claim with the insurance company to receive your refund of cancellation penalties for covered reasons from the insurance company. I accept it is my responsibility to review travel documentation for accuracy including name spellings, dates, and the itinerary and understand that I am responsible to contact Accent on Travel upon receipt if any information appear incorrect. I understand that changing any aspect of my travel arrangements may result in additional fees being applied to my purchase. I have been advised that the name, date of birth and gender that appears on the identification card must exactly match the same such data that is listed on my airline ticket and in my booking records. I understand that the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) requires me to carry a government-issued identification card in order to board a flight. I acknowledge that my failure to strictly comply with these requirements may result in denied boarding or an undue delay at an airport security checkpoint causing me to miss my flight. I further acknowledge that beginning on May 3, 2023, I must present a driver's license or another form of identification that complies with the requirements of the Federal Real ID Act (see www.dhs.gov/real-id for more information).

I have been advised that the suppliers whose names have been supplied to me are those who are responsible for the travel services I have purchased. I consent to and request the use of those suppliers and agree not to hold Accent on Travel responsible should any of these suppliers: 1) fail to provide the travel services I have purchased; 2) fail to comply with any applicable law; or 3) become insolvent/bankruptcy; 4) claim a freeze on services or payments due to an unforeseen event – Force Majeure, 5) engage in any negligent act or omission that causes me any sort of injury, damage, delay or inconvenience. I understand that the use of a credit card offers me more opportunities to dispute the charge should a vendor cease operating. I accept that Accent on Travel is not responsible for, nor will I attempt to hold it liable for, any injury, damage or loss I may suffer on account of any conditions, actions or omissions that are beyond its reasonable control. I further understand and acknowledge that travel to many parts of the world may involve the risk of a variety of hazards to my health and/or safety, including but not limited to disease, crime, terrorism, and warfare. I acknowledge travel plans may be interrupted or cancelled by the supplier that is providing them, a government entity or a third party over which Accent on Travel has no control. I further acknowledge that the supplier's own cancellation, rebooking and refund policies, subject to any applicable law that is now or may later be in effect, will govern my rights and remedies, including my right to receive a refund, in such an event. I hereby hold Accent on Travel harmless and release it from any and all liabilities for any damages, including but not limited to monetary losses, I may incur as a result of such interruption or cancellation of these travel plans.
